## Transport (World Cup Rules Art. 11)

- Official airport : Montreal (YUL)
- Alternative airport : Québec (YQB)
- The organizing committee will arrange transportation between the airports and the hotels. One transfer (round trip) free of charge per team.
- Information to the Shuttle service from Montreal (YUL)
  - Bus: Up to 40 pax - TBC
  - Mini-Bus : Up to 20 pax - TBC
  - Minivan : Up to 5 pax - TBC
- Information to the Shuttle service from Quebec (YQB)
  - Bus : Up to 40 pax - TBC
  - Mini-Bus : Up to 20 pax - TBC

### **Transportation application deadline : March 4, 2019**

Local shuttle service is not provided since the hotel is walking distance to the venue.

#### **Reimbursement (World Cup Rules Art. 10 and 13)**

- Accommodation costs:
  - Teams can pay directly their hotel. Payment in the hotels may be done in cash (CAD or USD only) or by credit card.
  - Over quota costs are to be paid by cash or credit card.
- Transportation cost:
  - All transportation costs can be paid at the race office upon arrival or upon request if applicable. Payment may be done in cash (CAD only) or by credit card.
- Carrying costs/Reimbursement :
  - Expenses sheets will be received in financial office during the race weekend or by email: Payments will be done by bank transfer.

#### **Regulations of radio equipment:**

- Industry Canada may require on-site radio inspections in order to confirm use of approved radio frequencies. If so, Information about radios will be communicated to teams at each venue. Please bring only programmable radios if possible to ensure you will get a radio channel.

#### **Waxing facilities (World Cup Rules Art. 14)**

- Wax cabins : Available from Monday 18/03/2019 **at 8:00**
- The keys to the cabins are available at the wax village office
- Canada uses 120v electricity, transformers for 220v will be available on a limited basis at each venue
- A deposit of 1000,00 CAD will be required upon arrival via credit cards to cover any cost related to any damages regarding to the waxing facilities. The deposit shall be reimbursed 60 days after the last day of competition.

#### **Regulation of VISA**

- Electronic Travel Authorization
  - New entry requirements now in effect : visa-exempt foreign nationals who fly to or transit through Canada need an Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA). Exceptions include U.S. citizens and travellers with a valid Canadian visa. Canadian citizens, including dual citizens, and Canadian permanent residents cannot apply for an eTA.

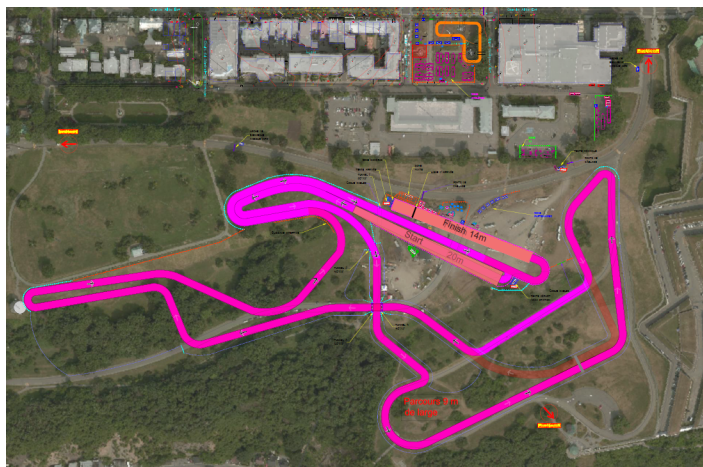
